Re: 2010 Hawaii Diesel Transition

Dear Mr. Morin:

Please be advised that Chevron will be undergoing a diesel transition in Hawaii to comply with the EPA Transportation Fuel requirements that become effective June 1, 2010 for the Chevron Hawaii Refinery and August 1, 2010 for Chevron Hawaii terminals. The Port Allen terminal will be undergoing its diesel transition between June 1, 2010 and July 31, 2010. During the transition period off-road dyed diesel will not be available at the rack due to logistical supply constraints at the Port Allen terminal.

Clear Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel will be available at the Port Allen rack during the transition period to serve both on-road and off-road diesel customers. Unfortunately, off-road diesel customers will be charged with on-road federal and state diesel taxes. However, customers can file for an off-road diesel tax refund. Refund forms and information can be found using the links below:

We expect to complete the diesel transition and to have off-road Ultra Low Sulfur Dyed Diesel available by August 1, 2010. If unforeseen issues occur we will communicate changes to you immediately.
